Course Description:

This 16 hour course provides the Company Officer (CO) with the basic leadership skills and tools needed to perform effectively in the fire service environment. The course addresses ethics, use and abuse of power at the CO level, creativity in the fire service environment, and management of the multiple roles of the CO.

Selection criteria :

- Line fire officers, unit commanders, or program supervisors.
- Fire or rescue personnel due for promotion/appointment to officer rank or supervisory position within six months.
- Training officers, staff, or administrative officers of fire and rescue organizations.
