Intent to Participate

To participate in the 2017 Penobscot County Fire Academy (if selected) candidates must be covered by a Fire Department's Worker's Compensation policy; not presently drawing Worker's Compensation benefits; meet the requirements of Maine Respiratory Protection Standard (1910.134); and are aware of the physical demands of firefighter training exercises. All candidates must have an active fit test and repertory physical on file with their respective department before attending the hands on portion of the academy.

Each Member selected will need a copy of Jones and Bartlett: Fundamental of Firefighter Skills 3rd edition with Navigate online access. All bookwork **MUST** be completed prior to arriving at the hands on portion. Book order information will be provided after the final selection date.

Final selection of participants will be made on May 30, 2017 by the Penobscot County Fire Chiefs' Executive board of directors and the academy coordinator. Consideration shall be given during the selection process to ensure that as many departments and communities are represented as space allows. The candidate selection process will follow the following criteria:

1. Candidates in the Live-In Student Internship Program.
2. Candidates from active, dues paying, fire departments from the Penobscot County Chiefs' Association
3. Candidates from departments that are legacy supporters of the Penobscot County Fire Academy
4. Candidates from other Penobscot County fire departments
5. Candidates from Maine

A \$150.00 fee for enrollment will be assessed for each member selected for the academy to be paid prior to the start of the hands on portion. Purchase orders are accepted.

Money should never deter an individual or department from participating. Please contact the Penobscot County Fire Chiefs' Association in reference to scholarship opportunities.
